This, together with very limited tidal options and other castle attractions means we need to keep this sort of time slot for future events in Arundel. Congratulations to James Phillips (Les Stables Triathlon) who set a new course record with 1:53:04 closely followed by Henry Eaton (Army Triathlon) 1:53:26 and Hugh Bradshaw (University of Bristol) in 1:54:02. Similarly, Becky Schofield (Tri-Anglia) shattered the previous course record with a time of 2:09:29, followed by two other great performances from Katrina Rye (Army Triathlon) and Hannah Ewens (Crystal Palace) in 2:10:45 and 2:10:48 respectively.

First veterans were Iain Robertson (Torq) in 1:56:15 who was almost a couple of minutes up on previous course record holder Colin Dixon (PHCC) in 1:58:07. Mireille Cook from Newbury was first female vet in 2:11:51 with Coventry Tri's Anita Howe second in 2:16:05. Supervet winners were Simon Taylor (Brighton Tri Club) in 2:06:27 and Anne Maskell (Giant Cornwall) in 2:23:02. Seamus Sheard from Tri3 was the first Junior in 2:03:58. Team Tri Hards dominated the relay race in 2:08:53 in what is their best time to date; Mark Straw, Elliot Brown & Paul Brookbank making up the team.
